



GTHS Kinesiology Locker Room Expectations: 2017-2018

- 1. Teachers and Locker Room Attendants are there for your safety. Each teacher has the same responsibility in the locker room and outside in the waiting area. Please see anyone who is close by if you are in need of help.**
- 2. Locker Room Attendants are to be respected at all times when in the locker room. Please remember that if you are questioned or given direction by a locker room attendant it should be followed immediately. Please remember that failure to follow directions given by district personnel will result in disciplinary actions based on the severity of the violation.**
- 3. Students must be in the locker room on time to ensure they receive proper time to dress for class. Students have 5 minutes after the tardy bell to finish dressing and report to their number for roll call. At the end of the period students will have 3-5 minutes to get to the locker room (depending on what facility they are at) and then 5 minutes to dress back into their street clothes.**
- 4. Each student will be assigned a small individual locker that is to be used only for P.E. items. Students will only be allowed in the locker room during their period of P.E. unless escorted by Campus Security. The locker room is NOT open during lunch times.**
- 5. The long locker for students to use has the same corresponding number as their small locker. Students with locker 1A should use long locker 1 during their period of P.E.**
- 6. Students who leave a lock on an unassigned small locker or a long locker will have a note placed on the locker and have 3 days to remove the lock and items. After 3 days the lock will be removed and items will be placed in the lost and found.**
- 7. Do NOT Share lockers with others or give out your combination to others. Locks can be purchased at the Student Store.**
- 8. Lock up your items PLEASE! Remember GTHS is NOT responsible for lost or stolen items in the locker room.**
- 9. If a student changes their P.E. period, it is their responsibility to see either their Teacher or the Locker Room Attendant to change their small locker. At the end of the year all locks will be cut off of the lockers after the last day of Finals.**
- 10. No FOOD or DRINK is allowed in the locker room. Water bottles are ok, but please throw away or store items in your backpack prior to entering the locker room. Let's keep our Locker Rooms Clean!**
- 11. No Electronic Devices are allowed to be visible in the locker room! No pictures are allowed to be taken at any time in the locker room. Students may expose themselves to suspension, explosion, or even criminal charges if caught doing so. A teacher or locker room attendant will confiscate the electronic device immediately. The electronic device will then be available for pick up from the Assistant Principal's office ONLY by a parent.**
- 12. Students are to enter and exit the locker room through pre-determined doors. Please be respectful and follow the signs that have been placed throughout the locker room.**
