What are your biggest concerns with your student(s) in Distance Learning?

The lack of interpersonal associations with their teachers and peers. R: This is difficult in a distance learning environment. Please take advantage of instructional time as well as office hours provided by teachers, tutoring opportunities after school and in the evenings, and clubs and activities that most sites are beginning to put together.

The change of teachers so many times, students become frustrated with that. R: This is always a concern at the beginning of the year especially as we have had to prepare for both distance learning and an eventual return to school in hybrid. We should be past this at this point except for a few circumstances or where an emergency has occurred.

That they fall behind. I personally feel as if less importance is given to my children because they are in distance learning. It seems to me that students on hybrid model are given more importance. R: All students are currently in a distance learning model at this point. Please contact your teacher or school site with specific concerns and they should be able to address them.

That there are many distractions at home which perhaps cause that our children are less focused and also the distance between them and their teacher. R: As much as possible,

please try to provide a quiet space for your child to work during school hours. We realize this is not an easy task depending on the number of people in the household.

That they don't learn or understand in the same way they did when they were at school in person. R: This is difficult in a distance learning environment. Please take advantage of instructional time as well as office hours provided by teachers, tutoring opportunities after school and in the evenings, and clubs and activities that most sites are beginning to put together.

Above all, that English language development is not happening. R: Please contact the teacher and/or site administration to discuss the needs and progress in your child's classroom.

That I can have certainty that children are achieving to expectations R: This is difficult in a distance learning environment. Please take advantage of instructional time as well as office hours provided by teachers, tutoring opportunities after school and in the evenings, and clubs and activities that most sites are beginning to put together.

That my child be attending all his classes because I do not know if he is or not. I don't understand much of the stuff online. R: Please contact your child's teacher for attendance information. You can also find this information on Parent Portal. Please look for more district and site parent trainings on this information.

That they fall behind academically and that with time, so much interaction with devices and after some time that their social skills suffer and they become quieter and unable to interact socially; able to speak up when they need help. R: This is difficult in a distance learning environment. Please take advantage of instructional time as well as office hours provided by teachers, tutoring opportunities after school and in the evenings, and clubs and activities that most sites are beginning to put together.

I worry that students won't reach the grade level they need to for this school year because they are not attending school in person. R: This is a common concern across the country. Our teachers are working hard to support student learning and fill the gaps due to extended time away. We will work to support our students to all meet grade level standards. Please take advantage of academic support through your teacher, office hours, and site and district tutoring available.

That teachers are not available in moments when our kids have questions and the questions come up after the teacher presented the lesson. For example, the first week of school one of my daughters was unaware that her teacher had a live session and she entered her classroom and all but there was no sign anywhere that the class was meeting live. She realized until after the fact. This made her nervous because she got scared her teacher would mark her absent. All this worries me. R: We understand there are obstacles in distance learning. Please try to communicate with your child's teacher or school site as much as possible to stay aware of schedules and please participate in site and district tutoring as available.

That kids be applying themselves daily R: This has been a struggle in some cases. It is

importance to continue to stress the importance of attending class and completing assignments so as to continue learning at grade level.

There are so many distractions at home! And being away from their teacher doesn't help.

R: As much as possible, please try to provide a quiet space for your child to work during school hours. We realize this is not an easy task depending on the number of people in the household.

I think my child is doing well. So far so good. R: That is great to hear!

I don't see any progress in his class. She is with her teacher only one hour and I could say that is very little to no work. One hour is not enough for my daughter to learn and advance in her learning. I must say I understand things are different and hard but this is not right.

R: Please contact the teacher and/or site administration to discuss the needs and progress in your child's classroom.

That my daughter's achievement decreases and that his learning may too. R: This is a common concern across the country. Our teachers are working hard to support student learning and fill the gaps due to extended time away. We will work to support our students to all meet grade level standards. Please take advantage of academic support through your teacher, office hours, and site and district tutoring available.

In our case, we have been with our son all along in this new learning mode. We have not had any barriers. I have noticed a change in the pedagogy that some teachers offer and that gives me peace of mind.

If something worries me is the linguistic competencies because that is a challenge. My son has been reclassified but even though he is no longer considered an English learner, I definitely think he needs to have those conversations in English.

He practices his English when he watches movies, series, listens to music or watches news but at home we speak Spanish only. R: Please continue to stress the importance of continuing the conversations he is having. Please contact his teacher to make them aware of any struggles or concerns.

What worries me is that I cannot help as much as I wish but I feel that teachers help me quite a bit. R: Glad you are finding help. Tutoring should begin now as well for more support for students.

I believe my child is not learning what is needed. R: Please contact your child's teacher or site administrator to have a conversation regarding your concerns.

I would like that kids could learn as much as when they go to school in person. R: That is the goal we are trying to attain.

Classes are offered with very limited time. R: Please take advantage of office hours and tutoring during times classes are not available.

That teachers assign a lot of work for students to do on their own and there are times when the tasks are foreign to my child and I don't know how to help! R: Please take advantage of office hours and tutoring during times classes are not available.

Well, it is not the same to be in school in person. With my youngest, I have to be right there for her to not get distracted. R: We realize this puts a large responsibilities on families to support learning. We are glad you are able to support him.

I feel that kids are not putting forth as much effort. R: Please stress with your child the importance of working just as hard in a distance learning environment as in a hybrid environment so that they stay up with the class.

I speak for my son when I say that students are not as engaged. Teachers are giving the lesson and kids don't pay attention. I am having lots of trouble with that. R: Please stress with your child the importance of working just as hard in a distance learning environment as in a hybrid environment so that they stay up with the class. Office Hours and tutoring are also available for support.

It truly worries me because I feel that students are not learning enough and they don't participate in class they way they should. I would like for teachers to connect with students longer. I see they get so many breaks and so frequently. They connect from 9:15 to 9:20 and then they have a 15 minute break? That in my opinion is an exaggeration. R: Please contact your child's teacher or site administration for supports that are available to your student.

The interaction with teachers and the moments to ask questions, that is not the same. R: We realize there is less interaction time. Please take advantage of all opportunities through office hours and individual tutoring to support your student.

I feel worried that students don't participate and express their opinions. This causes that we don't know if the child is understanding the class and I would like that attendance did not take as much time from the session. I would like for every class time to leave some learning, some practical knowledge behind not only to tell them that they have work to do and leave it like that. R: Please discuss with your child's teacher or site administrators to support your child's individual needs. Office hours and tutoring are available for support as well.

Well, it is not the same level of excitement to connect online and it is stressful for me! I want my child to turn on the camera and kids don't. It is important that they do. Please, that teachers make students turn the camera on. If teachers don't see their students it's as if the students were not present. Please, you tell them! R: While we would like to see the faces of all of our students and hope they turn their cameras on, there are circumstances where this may not be possible.

What are your biggest concerns with your student(s) if/when we return to school in a hybrid 50/50 model?

Try to offer more interactive programs which would engage our children. R: Sites are working on enrichment activities to provide this interaction.

Student conferences with motivational people, workshops for parents, a card for us to buy food for families with low income and who are unable to pick up school meals. R: We are working on student activities at the sites and sites should be contacting parents, parent workshops are being offered by sites and the district. Please check your communication and websites for this information. Re: cards for meals, this was a State program and we provided notification that it was available. If offered again we will try to make you aware. We are only able to provide meals through our Nutrition Services program.

Have more teachers. They have a lot of kids in their class. They have to split their classes in two schedules, one at 7;00 another one at 12:00 and at 1;00 and at 5:00 p.m. It would be better. R: We are constantly reviewing numbers to meet the needs of our students.

Please provide any additional feedback on how you feel the first 2-weeks of school have been for your student.

Good R: Glad to hear!

Teachers are doing there best. Students and parents need to take accountability. R: We hope everyone tries their hardest to make distance learning successful

They have been stressful for my kids my high school student has also had issues with some teachers and the load of work they are given R: We understand it has taken time to get used to this model of teaching and we are all doing our best to support all stakeholders. Consider tutoring and/or homework help options.

Not happy with the way the district level is handing things. I feel that they truly don't care about the students and they only care about meeting guidelines which are impossible to attain.

My student was also never invited to attend class for the first week. I had to email to figure out what is going on and I am a parent who knows the system. What about parents who don't oh well. R: We are sorry you did not have a good experience to start the year. Hopefully it has gotten better. We are all doing our best to support our students and teachers.

Is more stressful for me than for them R: This transition to distance learning has added increased stress. Please let us know how we can be of help. There are additional resources for support on our district website. Also, please speak to your child's teacher or school administration for additional support.

I feel like students need more learning R: Please speak with your childs teacher for additional enrichment activities that can be used with your student.

I was feeling in the 2 weeks of distancing learning for my child is wasn't easy he would get distracted and not pay attention and have a hard time by filling the instructions. R: Please contact the teacher and or site for strategies to keep your child engaged.

For my student it sometimes doesn't feel as motivating to do school work, in goes back to the parent. We have to take on that role and find ways to engage them to their school work, by using techniques that teachers use in their classrooms. Creating a reward system works very well, and I can see that they participate a lot more. R: A reward system is great. Glad that is working. Distance learning does require more on the parents side and we appreciate all you are doing to support your child's education and success.

It's been challenging. R: We understand it is very challenging but hope you are able to work through the challenges. Please keep in communication with your teachers and school sites for more support if needed.

I think it has been positive. Great to hear!

It has not been that hard for them. It is a matter of following a schedule. Great to hear!

Lessons were more stressful in the beginning but we have adapted a bit... This is of course of no comparison as when students are in class. R: We agree! Glad your students are adapting.

It has been hard. Kids get distracted and we the parents have to work. We have limited time to be there with our kids to make sure they have all they need. I believe this will be a matter of students getting used to their schedules and getting used to this new system. R: We understand it is very challenging but hope you are able to work through the challenges. Hopefully your students have adjusted.

Excellent, thank you. Great to hear!

It has been a complete disaster in preschool. The teacher has not connected effectively and we can either hear, or see her during the lessons. We have to pick between one or the other! One of her aids uses her phone to connect her... it is obvious that she is trying but in reality, the "class" is of no substance.

In regards to elementary, with Dual Immersion, I think more English is necessary... I mean, activities that really favor language development following the amount of time that should be given to each language.

In middle school, very well! R: I'm sorry you have been having such a difficult time. Hopefully these issues have gotten better. Please speak to the teacher and/or site administration to work through some of the problems you have discussed.

The first week was quite stressful. I see that the students are adapting... there is improvement. R: Glad to hear it is improving.

I believe they were good. Great to hear!

They were so stressful! Both my daughters have had such a difficult time! Until today they were switched to hybrid because it would not be done upon my request. My daughter who is a junior has not had a single response from her counselor and or the school. For the first two weeks of school she did not have a single educational interaction. R: I am sorry to hear that. If you continue to have issues please contact the site admin or call the Secondary Director at 909-580-6542

So so...they need their teacher R: It usually takes a couple weeks to make sure all staff is in place especially with the changes this year.

They had been very good. But I have a complaint! All of a sudden my daughter was switched to another class and now she is considered behind with assignments in her new class! R: Please contact the school site administrator. When students move classes their work should move with them.

Hard, due to the need to adapt to a new system, one where the child is having to self-advocate and self-manage; it is a system that calls for discipline to be in class daily, to continue to be connected. R: We agree. I hope your child is adapting and is begin successful.

It is hard. Children get distracted and those of us who have to go to work lack the time to be there all along but it is necessary that they make adjustments to comply with schedules and get used to this new system. R: We understand it has taken time to get used to this model of teaching and we are all doing our best to support all stakeholders. Consider tutoring and/or homework help options.

Not good. My child has had four different teachers in two weeks! And only one hour of class. I don't think that is right. R: It usually takes a couple weeks to make sure all staff is in place especially with the changes this year. We are sorry you child has been moved so many times. These moves should no longer be occurring.

I believe they have been very good. Great to hear!

I see my son enthusiastic but also stressed out at times due to the amount of homework he has.

One of his teachers plays music they like as they do activities and that has had a good impact; it strengthens their sense of belonging and increases their self esteem, keeps them motivated to be present in body and mind and it impedes that they take class with their headphones on.

I want to thank the school district for being there with quality and professionalism and with warmth, and warmth is vital at this time. R: Thank you for your comments.

For some of my children it is easy; they learn fast! But for the little one it is tough. We are adapting to the programs and platforms that are used. I think teachers are well organized and when I reach out they help me. I am happy and grateful. R: Glad to hear some of your children are adapting and hopefully it gets easier on the little one. Distance learning is hardest on our youngest students.

They have been difficult because for parents who work...there are times when we cannot help. We understand it is very challenging but hope you are able to work through the challenges. Hopefully your students have adjusted.

Stressful. My son wants to go to school in person. He misses his peers and teacher. R: We all agree and hopefully we will be able to get back to school shortly when it is ssafe and feasible to do so. Please take advantage of clubs and activities that should be starting after school at your school site.

We are happy to be able to be back. It has not been easy. Many times, we could not log on and I am hopeful this does not have a negative impact on my children's attendance records. R: Hopefully this problem is still not occurring. If it is please contact the IT helpline to see if they can work with you on some of the connection issues.

A work overload. My wife closes the day with our daughter at about 7 p.m. with little or no breaks. R: I am sorry to hear that and hope as we get further into the semester this gets a little easier. Please contact your child's teacher or administrator to brainstorm ideas to support your childs progress.

I asked my daughters. They are happy. They were bored during vacation and now they

are kept busy. R: That is great to hear that are happy.

It has been a daily adaptation process to this new normal but I am pleased. R: That is great to hear.

I have two students in middle school also and all of them have fallen behind because I don't have connection due to the mountain (Reche Canyon,). Four kids and all of them expected to connect at the same time. I hope you are patient as we are being patient and that this is sorted out soon. R: We know we all need to be patient to make things better. Hopefully you have been able to address your internet concerns. We have hotspots available if that would help.
