Based on the ACS WASC mid-cycle review, it has been determined that Washington Alternative High School (9 - 12) meets the ACS WASC criteria for accreditation. This accreditation status is based on all of the information provided by the school, including the school's progress report, and the satisfactory completion of the on-site mid-cycle accreditation visit.

Washington Alternative High School's accreditation is now reaffirmed through the end of the six-year cycle ending in June 2023.

Accreditation status is conditioned upon Washington Alternative High School's continued adherence with the ACS WASC policies, procedures, and criteria for accreditation. This includes a requirement that an accredited school annually contribute members to participate on visiting committees. Failure to maintain compliance with said policies, procedures, and standards is grounds for modification and/or withdrawal of the accreditation.
