

Important Details...

Terrace View Elementary School offers the Colton Joint Unified School District's elementary visual and performing arts magnet program.

Because of space restrictions, only a limited number of students who apply for the magnet program will be accepted. Some grade levels may already be filled for next year. *Kindergarten enrollment at the home school is encouraged in the event your application is not approved.*

If your child is accepted to the magnet program, Terrace View would become his or her new full-time school through 6th grade

Under the transfer provisions, students must maintain a 95% satisfactory attendance rate and proper conduct at school and school related activities (No violations of Education Code that results in an off campus suspension). Failure to adhere to these conditions will result in revocation of the transfer and student will be enrolled in the school of residence.

District transportation will not be provided. Transportation must be arranged by parents/guardians.

The Colton Joint Unified School District is excited to offer the Fine Arts Magnet Program at Terrace View Elementary for the 2017-18 school year. Transportation is not provided. It will be the responsibility of parents/guardians to provide transportation to and from Terrace View Elementary.

Terrace View Elementary School is a California Distinguished School with a visual and performing arts component that is curriculum-based, which means that instruction in the disciplines of visual art, drama, music and dance is integrated in every classroom with language arts, mathematics, social studies, science and physical education.

The Magnet Program has four main goals:

- Every child receives instruction in the arts (music, dance, drama and visual arts), integrated in the daily curriculum.
- Every child has the opportunity to participate in a live performance during the school year.
- Every child has the opportunity to display a work of art during the school year.
- Every child has the opportunity to attend at least one live performance during the school year.

Instrumental music is made available three days a week during the school day to interested 4-6 graders. Fourth graders are given weekly music instruction with song flutes (recorders).



There are opportunities for 4-6 graders to participate after school in concert choir and show choir, as well as a full musical production performances.

Families applying from outside the district must obtain an inter district transfer from their home district. Transfers are **accepted** March 1, 2017 through April 17, 2017 at Student Services. The deadline to apply for the 2017-18 program is **April 17, 2017**. Applications received after the deadline will be placed on a wait list.

Students now attending Terrace View on an approved transfer do not need to reapply to the program.
