

DISNEYLAND GRAD NITE FRIDAY MAY 8, 2019 RAIN OR SHINE

Please read carefully as the following rules/guidelines will be strictly enforced.

Grad Nite will take place rain or shine. Seniors must arrive at GTHS no later than 8:15a.m., Friday, May 8, 2020. Please meet in the "E" parking lot. Buses will begin loading at 8:45a.m. Please have your ID ready to check in on the bus. **NO** food or drink will be allowed on the buses. Buses will depart from GTHS no later than 9:30a.m. Seniors will have access to Disney's California Adventure Park and Disneyland Park. The Grad Nite event will take place in California Adventure from 9:00p.m. until 2:00a.m. Students **MUST** be inside California Adventure no later than 9:00p.m., as the park will close to the public at 9:00p.m. Buses will return to GTHS on Saturday, May 9, 2020 at approximately 4:00a.m.

You do not need to report to any of your classes. Your attendance will be excused for the day.

Upon arrival at the Resort, attendees will be given a ticket to the event. Attendees are asked to write their name on their ticket. If tickets or wristbands are lost or stolen, they are non-replaceable.

Disney's goal is to create an environment that is enjoyable to everyone. Similar to the security screening process for all Resort guests, Attendees should expect bag checks and magnetometer screenings at the Resorts backstage screening area.

In conjunction with the Anaheim Police Department, security personnel will be conducting screenings for banned substances. Screenings will include bag searches and the use of drug-sniffing canines. If bag searches and/or drug-sniffing canines indicate the presence to marijuana (or any of its derivatives including marijuana enriched products) or any illegal narcotics/substance, attendee will be asked for permission to conduct additional screening.

If any banned substances are found on the bus or in the possession of an Attendee, the matter will be turned over to the Anaheim Police Department for further action. Parents will be contacted to come to pick up any student in violation.

The following items are prohibited for all Attendees:

- Alcoholic beverages and any illegal narcotics/substances.
- Marijuana (or any of its derivatives including marijuana enriched products), even if it has been legally prescribed to the student or chaperone.
- Self- defense or restraining devices (e.g., pepper spray, mace).
- Glass containers of any size or type including perfume/cologne bottles and reusable water bottles.
- All outside food and liquids including factory-sealed water bottles.
- Firearms, ammunition or weapons of any kind, or objects or toys that appear to be firearms or weapons.
- Fireworks or other similarly explosive and/or flammable objects.
- Laser pointers or other items deemed potentially harmful or disruptive including Bluetooth speakers.
- Smoking, vaping and electronic cigarettes.
- Selfie sticks and hand-held extension poles for cameras and mobile devices.
- Suitcases, bags, coolers or backpacks, with or without wheels that are larger than 24" long x 15" wide and 18" high.
- Musical Instruments.
- Large tripods or monopod stands and professional photography equipment and lighting.
- Recreational devices such as drones, remote control toys, skateboards, scooters, inline skate and shoes with built in wheels.
