Problem Behavior	<u>Minor: Classroom Managed</u> <i>Documentation/intervention should be logged in on MINOR behavior log; at least 3 violations on the <u>same offense</u> will then be considered a major.</i>	<u>Major: Office Managed</u> <i>Write major on a DDR and submit report (not student) to office. In case of emergency (unsafe classroom environment), call the office.</i>
DEFIANCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Off task - Ignore teacher requests - Nonverbal back talk: dirty looks, walking away, rolling eyes - Arguing/question authority - Leaving seat without permission - Knocking over chairs, tipping chair - Whining, throwing tantrums, pouting (interventions: parent contact, counseling, redirect/timeout in grade level classroom) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Blatant refusal - Leaving classroom without permission (intentional) - Whining, throwing tantrums, pouting (continues after applying interventions)
DISRESPECT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Arguing with other students - Teasing/making fun of/mock/eye rolling to peers - Tattling - Rumors - Using other's supplies without permission 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Continued rumors/harassment/threatening - Arguing/talking back with staff/subs - Stealing someone's personal belongings - Bullying: consistent harassment, targeting over a period time to attack a person, threats, intimidation, obscenity - Threatening teacher/staff
NOT FOLLOWING SCHOOL RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Littering - Dress code - Not lining up when the bell rings or whistle blows - Chewing gum - Eating in non-designated times, areas - Electronics/phones (1 or 2 times) - Leaving classroom without permission (nonintentional) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Repeated dress code violations (at least 3x) - Electronics/Phones: usage not appropriate or in possession of (at least 2x) - Leaving classroom without permission (intentional)
PHYSICAL CONTACT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Accidental touch/contact - Continued contact after warning - Play fighting/rough play - Throwing objects - Any type of body contact: hugging, tickling, carrying/swinging others, etc... 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Premeditation/cause physical harm to others - Inappropriate touching/contact (including kissing, sexual advances, spitting at others) - Bullying: consistent harassment, targeting over a period time to attack a person, threats, intimidation, obscenity
IMPROPER USE OF PERSONAL / SCHOOL PROPERTY	<p><i>Damage that results in the destruction or disfigurement of property and can be easily repaired/replaced. This includes but is not limited to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Accidentally/playfully poking others with equipment - Unintentionally drawing on school equipment - Kicking desks, doors to interrupt others - Pretending personal/school equipment is a weapon - Minor bathroom misbehavior - Misuse of playground equipment 	<p><i>Damage that results in the destruction or disfigurement of property and cannot be easily repaired/replaced. This includes but is not limited to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pulling of fire alarm - Destruction of classroom/school equipment, books, personal property, clothes, graffiti, tagging, carving on any school property - Destruction of another person's property
PROFANITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Occasional outbursts - Writing notes with profane words - Using/pointing middle finger (including 'at others') - Sexual comments or gestures - Name calling - Swearing / minor cussing (not directed to another person) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Racial/gender slurs - Habitual use of swearing/curse words (documented at least 3x) - Deliberate cursing directed at an individual - Continual notes using profanity (documented at least 3x) - Harassing and continuous sexual comments or gestures - Vulgar conversations
