Application for Provisional Appointment to Serve on the CJUSD Board of Education



The Colton Joint Unified School District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to fill the current vacancy on the CJUSD Board of Education through November 2020.

Board Member Responsibilities

The Governing Board is elected by the community to provide leadership and citizen oversight of the District's schools. The Board shall work with the Superintendent to fulfill its major roles, which include:

1. Setting a direction for the District
2. Providing a basic organizational structure for the District by establishing policies
3. Ensuring accountability
4. Providing community leadership on behalf of the District and public education

Provisional Appointment (Board Bylaw 9223)

In order to draw from the largest possible number of candidates, the Board shall advertise in the local media to solicit candidate applications or nominations. A committee consisting of less than a quorum of the Board shall ensure that applicants are eligible for Board membership and announce the names of the eligible candidates. The Board shall interview the candidates at a public meeting, accept oral or written public input, and select the provisional appointee by a majority vote.

Education Code 35107

In order to serve on the Board, a person must meet the following eligibility requirements:

(a) Any person, regardless of sex, who is 18 years of age or older, a citizen of the state, a resident of the school district, a registered voter, and who is not disqualified by the Constitution or laws of the state from holding a civil office, is eligible to be elected or appointed a member of a governing board of a school district without further qualifications.

Term

May 2019 through November 2020

Trustee Area

Eligible candidates must be registered voters and live in the school district's Trustee Area #3, which includes the City of Grand Terrace and some southern parts of Colton.
